Water Well & Solar Pump Project

We are pleased to announce that we have received additional funding this year from a generous sponsor to drill and establish a new water source for a solar-powered safe water system at a local community school. The school is Jabatshaba Primary School, located in Menyezwa near Gwayi River. It has an enrollment of 220 children who currently carry water daily for all learners and staff from the community borehole about 300m away. This community borehole does not provide sufficient water for the school and community, so a rotation system is in place with other water sources. Additionally, this source dries up in the winter during the dry season and water is then transported daily from 3km away. This new solar powered water project will greatly benefit the students of this school and contribute to the education and improved health for the whole community.

Below are images of previous solar powered water projects we have constructed at nearby schools in Gwayi River. These boreholes are designed to tap into deep aquifers and pump water into storage tanks to be used throughout the day using solar energy. This environmentally friendly and sustainable water project will eliminate the time spent on collecting and transporting water from distant boreholes and provide the necessary volume of water the school needs.
