Dubai Team Highlights

A Journey of Faith, Grit, and God's Power

In June 2025, a team of eight young adults from Well of Life Church, Dubai embarked on an apostolic mission to Zimbabwe, partnering with New Life Community Services to serve the community of Gwayi River. The goal was simple yet significant—to bring both practical relief and the hope of Jesus to rural schools and families in need.

Overcoming Challenges with God's Strength

Our mission began with unexpected delays when the delivery truck carrying 24 tons of maize was held up for two days. What was meant to be a three-day operation suddenly had to be done in just one day. Undeterred, the team woke before sunrise on Wednesday morning, arriving at the base of a mountain of maize stacked high on the truck. With prayer, teamwork, and supernatural endurance, we loaded the first batches onto three vehicles, split into smaller groups, and began the long drive through the beautiful Zimbabwean bush. By the grace of God, 24 tons of maize were delivered in a single day—feeding children for the next three months. Each of the eight schools—Gwayi River Primary,

Gwayi River Secondary, Mazwa Primary, Lubimbi Primary, Hankana Primary, Chamoira Primary, Mabale Primary, and Fatima School—received their allocation, ensuring thousands of students would have consistent meals through the coming term.

Meeting Physical Needs and Sharing Eternal Hope

At every school stop, we not only offloaded maize but also shared the gospel of Jesus Christ. Our team presented the message of salvation with clarity and joy, and we witnessed many students respond to the call of faith. Afterward, we

prayed individually for every child, believing for lasting transformation in their hearts and communities.

We also delivered clothing donations to Gwayi River Primary and Mazwa Preschool, blessing children with much-needed garments and showing God's love in tangible form.

A Night of Worship and Revival

That same evening, after a full day of labor and travel, the team hosted a Prayer and Worship Night with the Gwayi community. The presence of God filled the gathering

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as songs of praise rose from hearts overflowing with gratitude. Local believers were strengthened, and many were encouraged to stand firm in faith, knowing they are part of a global family of believers.
